Builds Capacity for Sustainable Integration



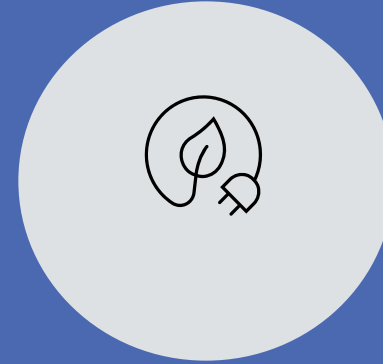
Integrating sustainability into procurement processes and systems can build capacity in sustainability integration across the organization.

Catalyzes Supplier Transformation



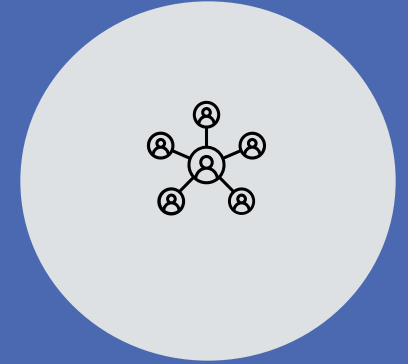
Use your purchasing power to encourage suppliers to adopt more sustainable practices, which can reduce risks and costs. Be a market mover not a price taker!

Minimize risk of engaging with suppliers with poor reputations while increasing your own reputation as a company with sustainable sourcing.

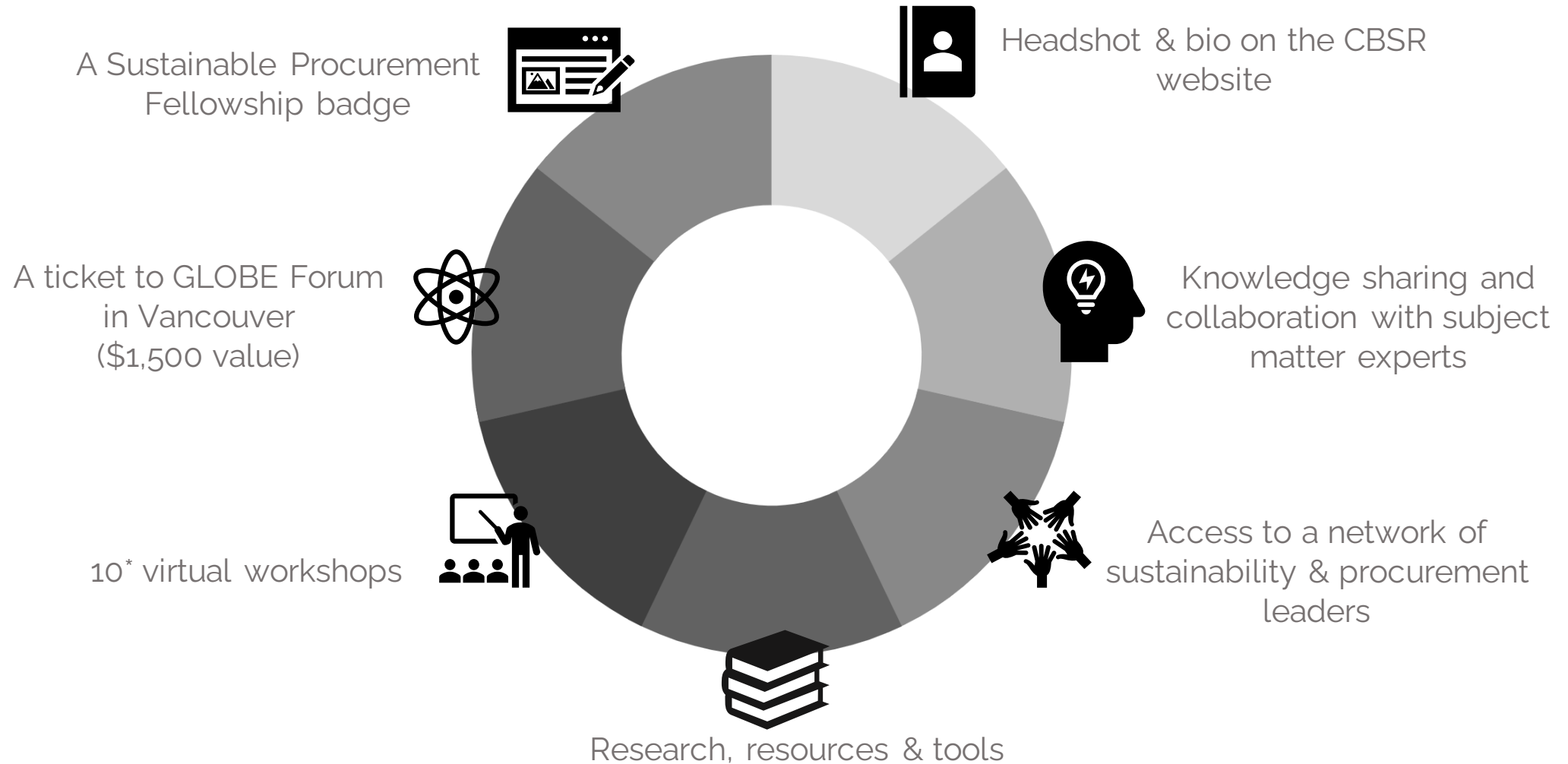
Increases Circularity and Supply Chain Resilience

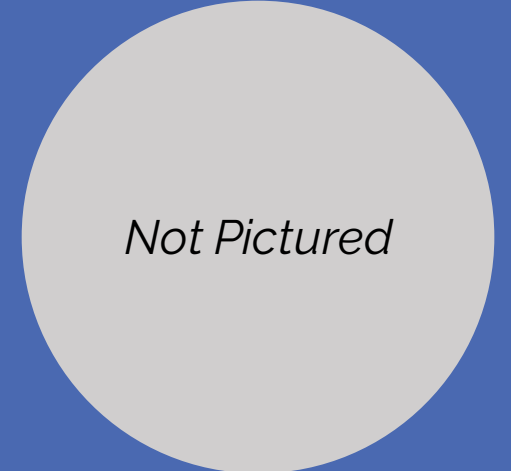
