Ten times a year, CBSR delivers concise insights on emerging policy, regulatory, and disclosure trends across Canada, the U.S., and globally (paused in July–August). Each brief highlights what matters for your business and is archived in the Member Portal for easy year-round reference.

#### **Peer Coaching Circles**

Small, cross-sector groups (4–6 peers) matched by goals and experience. CBSR convenes the first meeting, and circles then self-organize to exchange ideas, challenges, lessons learned, and build trusted professional connections.

#### **Regional Meetups**

In-person gatherings that combine light programming, networking, and connection. These sessions celebrate member leadership, spotlight stories of progress, and bring together sustainability leaders from across regions.

#### **Virtual Pop-ups**

Short, high-value virtual sessions on emerging issues — from new reporting standards to policy shifts. These “rapid-response” discussions help members stay ahead of change and share perspectives in real time.
